Robert Turnbull from *The Backyard Bard* performs Luke's Gospel word-for-word in an epic feat of memory. In the tradition of Alec McCowen's 1978 Tony nominated performance of Mark's Gospel, '*Jesus: According to Luke*' reveals the drama residing in this ancient biblical text. Using merely a chair and two milk crates, Robert recreates each scene and character using the powerful craft of storytelling.

Melbourne theatre company *The Backyard Bard* has produced Shakespearean and Biblical Storytelling productions since 2003. Robert has played lead roles in *Daniel* (2005), *Elijah* (2007) and *Elisha* (2008). He also directed *Esther* in the 2006 Melbourne Fringe Festival. He is performing both *Jesus: According to Luke* and *The Book of Revelation* in the 2009 Melbourne Fringe Festival. This means he will have performed almost 25% of the New Testament and 9% of the entire Bible.

The Gospel of Luke was written in the second half of the first century by a doctor who used eye-witness sources to compile his chronicle of Jesus' life. His account presents a radical Jesus, despised for his scandalous social behaviour and celebrated by outsiders and the destitute.

Told with humour, passion and even Scottish angels, *Jesus: According to Luke* will appeal to both the Homer Simpsons and the Ned Flanders among us.
