

For the past six years, The Backyard Bard, a Melbourne-based Christian theatre group, has produced several large-scale Biblical Storytelling productions. We have brought stories from the Gospel of Mark, Judges, Daniel and Esther to communities across Victoria. This year we are excited to announce that we are preparing to tell the amazing story of **Elijah**.

Each year we offer churches, high schools and universities the opportunity to host performances, and we would like to extend this invitation to your community.

Our Biblical Storytelling productions are a unique way of communicating a large section of God's Word in a medium that is both powerful and entertaining. We have also found that that they are a fantastic event for communities to run for several reasons:

### • It's effective evangelism.

The Word of God is declared clearly and boldly and we go to great lengths to ensure that the message is understood and that Jesus is the ultimate focus.

## • It's an easy event to invite friends and outsiders to.

Storytelling is naturally interesting and unthreatening for a post-modern culture.

### • The audience becomes interested in reading the Bible for themselves.

Both Christians and non-Christians are often surprised that the Bible contains such exciting and entertaining content.

### • It is low-effort to host.

The entire event, from the performance itself to the front of house, can be run by The Backyard Bard team. Also, Storytelling always works best with minimal sets and props so there is minor disruption to your venue. All we ask of our hosts is that they support the event and get excited about promoting it to their community. We will provide a short audio-visual promo, as well as all the posters and postcards you need to help you do this.

The story of Elijah is from 1 Kings 17 - 2 Kings 2 and our production will run for about 90 minutes. It contains some of the most remarkable stories in the Bible whilst declaring the powerful message about the reality of God. We will be performing the show from the middle of September through to the end of October, so please book us in as soon as possible. We will be charging tickets for the show at \$10. When it is inappropriate to charge an entry fee (for example, if the storytelling is in the place of a normal church service) we ask the host to pay \$450. These arrangements are flexible and we are happy to discuss them together.
